

Times Square Entertainment has followed the CDC, Harris County and State protocols relative to the pandemic since day one. Not only did we sanitize throughout the center, but initially, we quarantined all of the bowling balls to ensure that they were sanitized immediately before use. After Governor Abbott lifted the restrictions, we continued to require our employees to wear masks for several weeks. We are continuing to periodically sanitize our equipment and continue to provide sanitizing systems for guest to use.

At this time with so many people immunized over 95% of our guest are not wearing masks. Many of our employees have received both vaccination shots and at this time consistent with the CDC, we are not requiring our employees to wear masks. Many of our employees who have not been vaccinated are continuing to wear masks when near guests. When serving parties, if the party host or the majority of guests at the party, are wearing masks we are requiring our party host to wear a mask. If the party host and guest do not feel the need for masks, our employees may or may not wear a mask.

We are watching the increase of COVID cases as a result of the Delta variant. If the cases continue to rise, even without Harris County or the Governor requiring it, Times Square Entertainment will require any employee that is not vaccinated to wear a mask.

It has been proven that wearing your mask provides significant protection to you even if others are not wearing a mask. Based on the numerous physical altercations that have happened across the country when other businesses have required people to wear masks, our policy will remain to suggest that guests wear masks unless Harris County or the Governor makes it a legal requirement.
